

## **Teacher Lesson Plan**

## **Social Media Animation**

Objectives	Students will be able to:
	<ul> <li>Develop self-awareness around personal use of social media.</li> <li>Understand how the brain's reward pathway is triggered through social media use.</li> <li>Identify potential negatives to constant phone/social media use.</li> <li>Understand that social media platforms are money-making businesses.</li> <li>Identify strategies to find balance between social media use and other activities that one enjoys.</li> </ul>
Duration	45-60 minutes
Materials	Social Media Survey
	Social Media Animation
	Student Viewing Guide
Activity Outline	<ol> <li>Assign the Social Media Survey (link the survey here) to students to complete (can be assigned as homework before the classroom lesson).</li> <li>As a class, share responses and thoughts regarding various survey responses and general impressions after completing it.         <ul> <li>What surprised them?</li> <li>Did they learn anything new about their use of social media?</li> </ul> </li> <li>Distribute the Student Viewing Guide (link the SVG here).</li> <li>Ask students to complete the questions under the section marked "Before Watching."</li> <li>Watch the 3-minute animation (link the animation).</li> <li>Ask students to complete the remainder of the Student Viewing Guide.</li> <li>As a whole class, discuss the animation and the questions from the Guide.</li> <li>Read and discuss the tips for finding balance.         <ul> <li>Is there a strategy on the list that anyone has tried?</li> <li>Anything that someone would like to try?</li> <li>Does anyone have other ideas or suggestions?</li> </ul> </li> </ol>
