

## TEACHER LESSON PLAN

### Explicit Media Animation

<b>Objectives</b>	<p>Students will be able to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Understand that sexually explicit media depicts fantasy, not reality.</li> <li>• Define consent.</li> <li>• Identify messages regarding sexuality that are often portrayed in sexually explicit media.</li> <li>• Recognize the potential impacts of repeated exposure to sexually explicit media on the developing brain.</li> </ul>
<b>Duration</b>	<p>45-60 minutes</p>
<b>Materials</b>	<p><i>Student Viewing Guide</i>  <i>Student Viewing Guide - Answer Key</i>  <i>Explicit Media Animation</i>  <i>Extension Worksheet (Optional)</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◦ <i>Consent</i></li> <li>◦ <i>Healthy Relationships</i></li> </ul>
<b>Activity Outline</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Distribute the Student Viewing Guide.</li> <li>2. Ask students to complete the questions under the section marked “Before Watching.”</li> <li>3. Watch the 3-minute animation.</li> <li>4. Ask students to complete the remainder of the Student Viewing Guide.</li> <li>5. As a whole class or in small groups, discuss the animation and the questions from the Guide.</li> </ol>
